## A Note from the Parish Evangelization Support Team

As we prepare for a new year in Evangelization, Catechesis & Discipleship, I felt that it would be helpful to communicate some of the changes we have made, as well as the direction we are moving toward, in hopes of better serving you and your parishes.

When we say evangelization, we mean all the stages: Pre-Proclamation, Primary Proclamation, Catechesis & Discipleship. Or to say it even more simply: We want all people to belong to an authentic Christian community; whereby they encounter Jesus Christ in Word, Sacrament, and Testimony; that they desire to know and to follow Jesus more closely, so as to live as missionary disciples who **Radiate Christ** to the world.

So whether your emphasis is on catechesis or discipleship, whether your audience is youth, adults, or families, our team is here to assist you in your efforts of evangelization. We want to invite you -- DRE/CRE, Youth Minister, Adult Faith Formation Director, Pastoral Associate -- to participate in all the opportunities we are offering in the upcoming year. Opportunities for sharing life and prayer, and learning best practices so you are equipped for mission.

For those of you who work with the youth, you will see we are offering fewer events. We are blessed to have many youth apostolates and organizations surrounding us, such as NET, Damascus/CYSC, and Steubenville, that we are looking to partner with them and sponsor more events and opportunities to engage our young people. We know that while one-off events are good, they are made stronger when our youth are accompanied by an adult to and from the event; and we want to help equip more adults for this accompaniment.

As we prayed this past fall, we felt God prompting us to focus on three primary areas in parish evangelization:

- 1) Consult, Accompany, and Mentor Evangelists. Why? To equip ministers for the tasks of evangelization so they feel confident, are able to equip a team to work with them, and ultimately for the salvation of souls of those entrusted to their care.
- 2) Create opportunities for Communion for Mission. Mission for Communion. Why? We all need to encounter Jesus Christ, to grow as a community, and to open space for the Holy Spirit to renew parish evangelization structures.
- 3) Support our Evangelists through Hospitality, Encouragement, and Recognition. Why? It is a call and charism of the Christian life and crucial to supporting our evangelists and preventing burnout.
