How do I reserve the Statue of Mary?

Make your reservation here

How long will we have the Statute?

Reservations are arranged for either a **Friday – Monday** slot or a **Tuesday – Thursday** slot on any given week.

You are welcome to sign up for more than one spot if they are available.

Reservations are first come first serve.

Where do we get the Statue from?

You are responsible for procuring the Statue from the Parish that has the Statue reserved before you. Please coordinate with that parish to arrange a pick-up day. Unless organized otherwise, pick-up days will be:

Monday for the Tuesday -Thursday slot and

Friday for the Friday-Monday slot.

What comes with the Statue?

- A Platform to hold and/or process with the Statue
- A white skirt for the Platform
- Flowers for the base of the Statue
- A rain cover and PVC frame for the Platform (to be used for out-side Processions if needed)

How do I transport the Statue and the Platform?

The Statue has a custom build carrying case that will transport the statue safely.

The Platform has folding legs like a card table. When folded the dimensions are 36x36 in.

Please be prepared to with a vehicle with enough space for the carrying case and folded Platform

What are the dimensions of the Statue and the platform?

- **LxWxH of statue by itself:** 7x7x36 inches
- LxW of platform (in the table position): 36x36 inches
- **H of platform (in the table position):** 30 inches
- H of platform (in table position) + statue: 66 inches

Note: Often Doorways are not wide enough to carry the Platform through horizontally. Please carefully measure church doorways before planning a procession that would go through a doorway.
