WHO IS A YOUTH EVANGELIST?

An adult who is hired or appointed by the pastor to coordinate K-12 youth formation efforts in the parish (i.e. DRE, CRE, Youth Minister, Catechetical Leader, etc.)

WHO IS YOUTH EVANGELIZATION APPRENTICESHIP FOR?

New Youth Evangelists (0-2 years' experience in the field) working with Grades K-12

Newly hired or appointed Youth Evangelists (in the last 6-12 months) working with Grades K-12 (including added responsibilities in youth formation)

ROAD MAP

The Apprentice receives a Youth
Evangelization Mentor who personally
walks with them as they learn "the trade"
of Youth Evangelization. "The Road Map"
guides the Apprentice and Mentor as they
journey through the Youth Evangelization
Apprenticeship process together.

ROAD MAP 1

ONCE A MONTH - LESS MENTORING
Recommended for the youth evangelist
who seeks to stay sharp, brainstorm,
receive guidance

ROAD MAP 2

TWICE A MONTH - MODERATE MENTORING Recommended for the youth evangelist who seeks to have regular mentoring, learn new skills, have more guidance

ROAD MAP 3 THREE TO FOUR TIMES A MONTH FREQUENT MENTORING

Recommended for the youth evangelist who is just getting started; seeking weekly task management, tools, skills, and guidance

ROAD MAP PILLARS

LIFE AND PRAYER

personal Rule of Life: We seek to help the Apprentice thrive in all areas of their life, based on the holistic formation of a human person:

Spiritual, Human, Intellectual, and Apostolic.

FORMATION

INDIVIDUAL FORMATION PLAN (IFP):

We provide a formation plan that will best meet the needs for growth as a youth evangelist - books, training videos, practical applications, and other forms of education, skills building, and formation.

MISSION

ONSITE COACHING: We will be working one on one with the Youth Evangelist by applying what they're learning through their IFP directly and practically to the youth evangelization at the parish.

MISSION VISIT: The Mentor visits during one of the Apprentice's youth evangelization initiatives (i.e. event, class, volunteer formation, etc.). The mentor will offer encouragement, evaluations, coaching, follow-up, and suggestions for adaptations. The Mission Visit can also take the model of teach, show, do.
