Why a Communio Group?

- Parish ministry workers have a **vital** need for community
- These groups can help prevent burnout through support, prayer, and collaboration

What is a Communio Group?

- A Communio Group is a small group community made up of 6-8 fellow evangelists who want to share life and prayer with one another.
- Communio Groups are encouraged to use this time for brainstorming, collaboration, mentoring, and sharing of resources across parishes and ministries.
- Communio Groups may also decide to participate in ongoing formation through a book study, courses on Franciscan's Catechetical Institute or the like

How often do we meet?

- Communio Groups should meet at least once a month for 90 minutes.
- We will build in time for Communio Groups to meet during the Missio Days.

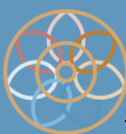
Forming a Communio Group:

- Gender specific
